


Review of vote center usage data

- Vote by mail has become the most popular voting method for California's voters.
- Vote centers have high traffic on e-1 and Election day.
- Vote center use is seeing a steady increase in VBM vote center drop off, especially on Election day.

Statewide and VCA counties: VBM most popular

VBM vs In-person voting methods in VCA counties and Statewide 2020 Primary through the 2024 General Election






